AI List Breed Specialist

For persons who have previously been approved by the K.C. to award CC's in the breed and have completed their First appointment. To have the support of the Lancashire & Cheshire Collie Club.

A1 Non Breed Specialist

This list contains those persons who this society would give their support and have previously been approved by the K.C. to award CC's in the breed.

A2 Breed Specialist

Persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with K.C. requirements and have been accepted by the K.C. for inclusion on the A2 list and have the support of the Lancashire & Cheshire Collie Club.A2 Non Breed Specialist — Persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and have been assessed in accordance with K.C. requirements and have been accepted by the K.C. for inclusion on the A2 list and have the support of the Lancashire & Cheshire Collie Club.A3 Breed Specialist A minimum of 7 years judging experience in the Breed and have the support of the Lancashire & Cheshire Collie Club. To have judges a minimum of 200 dogs not including repeat entries. To have stewarded at 12 shows. To have bred or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtain their First entry into the K.C. Stud Book. Save in exceptional circumstances K.C. Policy. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and Passed the relevant examination on the K.C. Regulations and Judging Procedures. To have attended a Confirmation and Movement "Hands on Assessment" conducted by a K.C. Accredited Trainer and Passed the assessment. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant K.C. Code of Best Practice and Passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

A3 Non Breed Specialist

A minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in this breed) and to have the support of the Lancashire & Cheshire Collie Club. To have judged a total of 200 different dogs. To have awarded CC's in at least one other breed.

B List Breed Specialist

To have 7 years experience owning and exhibiting this Breed and have the support of the Lancashire & Cheshire Collie Club. To have judged 20 classes of this Breed at Open or Championship Shows without CC's. To have judged 80 dogs of this breed. To have attended at least One Breed Specific judging seminar and Passed an assessment where applicable.

B List Non Breed Specialist

To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in any 1 Breed and have the support of the Lancashire & Cheshire Collie Club. To have judged 20 classes in this breed at Open and Championship Shows without CC'S. To have judged 80 Dogs of this Breed.

C List

Names of those persons who have the support of this Society but as yet do not fulfil the qualification to be included onto the "B List".
